- Less of your time and money getting new employees up to speed on Cloud business model and tools










## Past AWS Academy usage

- FA23: Voluntary full AWS Cloud Foundations course open to all UHM Business students
- FA23: AWS Cloud Architecting course and certification for MSIS student (pilot)

### **Future plans and aspirations**

- For-credit Cloud Business 1 (AWS Cloud Foundations) and Cloud Business 2 (AWS Cloud Architecting) courses
- New MSIS elective based on AWS Data Engineering course
- Incorporate more AWS Academy shortform courses into MIS & MSIS curriculum (Cloud Security, Machine Learning Foundations and NLP)









# Things to consider....

- UHM is not the first to do this... many other 4 year + universities are benefiting from AWS Academy (such as LSU)
- Instructors should be qualified on any AWS Academy courses they teach
- AWS moves fast & the AWS Academy curriculum changes with it – Instructors need to keep up with the changes
- If you don't require students to take the actual certification exam as part of their grade, > 80% will not

- Exam vouchers (50% off) available for AWS Academy member institutions, but not free – how will students pay for the cert exams if required?
- Finding your AWS Academy CPOC is not easy
- Use the AWS Academy LMS full or in part? Instructor-led or all asynchronous online?
- AWS certifications help students get interviews for internships and jobs. How do you make them aware?
